## University of Verona

The University of Verona is a young, dynamic university that invests in academic research and encourages teaching methods that promote personal and intellectual growth. More than **24.000 students** are supported by its **1.500 university staff** which include lecturers, researchers, technicians and administrative personnel, who contribute to the quality of student life by providing a solid framework of structural, financial and human resources.

The university also devotes special attention to community engagement and international experiences, implementing various forms of cooperation that encourage mutual cultural and economic growth. It currently has more than **300 active international cooperation agreements** with EU and non-EU universities, and its students and scholars participate extensively in international exchanges and research programmes.

Each year, more than **240 incoming students** have their Erasmus experience at the University of Verona, while **more than 600 outbound students** take part in European and non-European exchange activities.

International students from all over Europe as well as Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Japan, Mexico, South Korea,

Russia, Taiwan and the USA spend their study exchange period at the University of Verona, while more than **1.400 foreign students** are currently enrolled as full-time students.

The University of Verona has **12 departments** grouped into four main disciplinary areas: Law and Economics, Humanities, Life and Health Sciences, and Science and Engineering. The University currently offers **60** Bachelor's degrees, Master's degrees and short advanced study courses, **4** PhD Schools, **41** medical postgraduate specialisation courses and **1** postgraduate specialisation for law. In addition, it has introduced several new Master's degrees which are taught entirely in English.

## PhD Courses

There are **4 PhD Schools** covering the broad areas of Law and Economics, Humanities, Life and Health Sciences, and Engineering and Natural Sciences. Together, these four Schools offer **14** regular PhD programmes and three joint-university PhD programmes.

## Special fee for non-EU Students



Fees for international (non-EU) students are very affordable, set at €1,000 per year (~US\$1,070), independent of income. Scholarships are available, based on academic merit or financial need. ## Student Services



**Student Housing:** Italian universities do not usually have a campus system. Students may visit the International Relations Office for general enquiries and support in finding accommodation in Verona. After completing the application form, students will be provided with information about the types of accommodation available in Verona, either in the university's halls of residence or private flats in the area.



**Canteens:** The university has two canteens in Verona. International exchange students may be granted access to the university canteens with their student card, which provides two meals a day (lunch and dinner).



**Transport:** Thanks to the nearby airport (Verona Catullo), most major international and national cities are easy to reach. The main train station in Verona is not far from the university departments.

## Academic calendar



The academic year starts on 1st October and ends on 30th September. The first semester runs from September/October to the beginning of January, while the second semester runs from the end of February to the end of May. Assessments take place during the summer (June–July) or winter (December–February) sessions, but may also take place in autumn (September), depending on the field of study.

## Italian language course



Italian language courses are organised each semester at the University Language Center (CLA) to allow students to improve their language level and further develop intercultural skills to help them become accustomed to the Italian academic context and life. **AEGEE** Verona is a student organisation promoting cooperation, communication and integration in Europe through conferences, travel and holidays.




**ASE-ESN** Verona is a student association which organises important academic and leisure activities such as: support, help and tutoring for academic life, social events, international parties, guided tours and trips, and foreign language conversations with other students (Tandem).



**C.U.S.** Verona is a student centre that promotes sport as a tool for education, in collaboration with the Movement Science Department of the University. With the aim of improving health and wellbeing, the "Univr Sport" activities include fitness, indoor and outdoor activities available to students and staff, such as basketball, soccer, rugby, skating, kendo, canoeing, triathlon, fencing, horse riding, swimming, gymnastic, tennis, sailing, windsurfing and diving.



**FAN** - Fuori Aula Network ([www.fuoriaulanetwork.com](http://www.fuoriaulanetwork.com)) is the web radio of the University of Verona. It has been running since 2002 as a lab open to all students interested in communication and radio broadcasting activities. Students can apply to be a speaker, DJ or editor in Italian or their own native language.
