GENERAL INFORMATION**

ART. 1 – INTRODUCTION

1.1 The University of Verona, thanks to a network of agreements with foreign universities, offers international courses that enable students to gain a Double/Joint degree at the time of graduation. Indeed, students enrolled in a Double/Joint degree programme will be able to obtain both the degree of the University of Verona and the degree issued by the Partner University abroad - where they are expected to attend part of the programme -, in the time it normally takes to gain a common Master's degree. The institutions concerned shall ensure that both degrees are recognised in the two countries.

1.2 At the end of the Double/Joint degree programme, and after having passed the relevant exams at both universities, students will obtain two qualifications: one issued by the University of Verona, and the other from the Partner University.

ART. 2 – ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

2.1 Applications for Joint/Double degree programmes are open to applicants falling within one of the following categories: a) students, regularly enrolled at the University of Verona; b) students, regularly enrolled at another Italian university; c) graduates holding an Italian qualification that is among the entry requirements of their intended Double/Joint degree programme; d) candidates holding a qualification gained at a foreign university, subject to Eligibility Check (evaluation of entry requirements) for their intended Double/Joint degree programme: such students will need to follow the national regulations on admissions and/or recognition for foreign students (for further information please see: <https://www.univr.it/en/our-services/-/servizi/international-degree-seeking-students>).

2.2 As regards the limited-entry degree programmes included in this Call, admissions of students who have not yet enrolled in their intended degree programme will be conditional on them passing the relevant Admission Test.

ART. 3 – ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

3.1 Concerning admissions, a limited number of places are made available for each Double/Joint degree programme: the total number of eligible students is established each year, as indicated in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

3.2 The admissions criteria vary depending on the Double/Joint degree programme in which candidates intend to enrol, by the methods established by the Teaching Committee of each degree programme. The admissions criteria for each programme are set out in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

3.3 For each programme, the assessment of entry requirements will be carried out by a Joint Committee made up of members from each University concerned, or by a committee set up by the University of Verona specifically for the programme in question, subject to approval by the Selection Committee from the Partner University.

3.4 Admission to the Double/Joint degree programme and the enrolment are conditional on the student advancing their studies and/or gaining a sufficient number of ECTS/CFU credits during the first part of the programme at the University of Verona. Students will have their enrolment confirmed during the programme, by the deadlines and according to the procedures set out by the Teaching Committee of each programme, as set out in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

ART. 4 - JOINT/DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMMES - MAIN PROCEDURES

4.1 Students admitted to a Double/Joint degree programme register at the University of Verona and carry out a part of their studies at the Partner University, as indicated in the prospectus uploaded on the web page of the relevant degree programme, in the 'Double/Joint degree programmes' section.

4.2 Students will carry out their mobility during a specific period of their degree programme, as set out in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

4.3 The study plan which includes the modules to be taken at the University of Verona and at the Partner University is set up in advance and made available on the web page of the relevant degree programme, in the 'Double/Joint degree programmes' section.

4.4 In order to obtain the Double/Joint degree, it is necessary to achieve a certain number of ECTS/CFU credits at the Partner University, as set out in the study plan: these will be added to the ECTS/CFU credits to be gained at the University of Verona; the total number of ECTS/CFU credits required for obtaining a Double/Joint degree is the same as the total number of ECTS/CFU credits required for obtaining a common Master's degree (120 ECTS/CFU).

4.5 If the student fails to achieve the number of ECTS/CFU required during the period abroad at the Partner University, they will be excluded from the programme and from obtaining the Double/Joint degree. Since failing to obtain the Double/Joint degree does not necessarily mean that the student cannot continue their studies at the University of Verona towards the corresponding Master's degree, the student may still apply to the Teaching Committee of the relevant degree programme to obtain recognition of any ECTS/CFU gained at the Partner University, and request a transfer to the ordinary degree programme.

ART. 5 – STUDENT FEES AND CONTRIBUTIONS

5.1 Students, who will be enrolled as University of Verona students and will pay student fees and contributions at the University of Verona during the entire programme, will be welcomed at the Partner University in accordance with the current procedures in place for international students taking part in a mobility programme, based on the agreement entered into by the parties to establish the international Double/Joint degree programme.

5.2 No student/tuition fees shall be paid at the Partner University. However, the Partner University may ask the student to pay for other specific types of fees (e.g. regional student/stay fees etc). The student will have to pay for any other expenses related to the stay, travel and any other aspects not covered by the university enrolment.

ART. 6 – RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

6.1 Should mobility grants for Double/Joint degree students be awarded, the number of such grants will be indicated on the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

6.2 In the case of Double/Joint degree programmes based at a European Partner University, a number of Erasmus+ grants corresponding to the number of places available for the programme will be reserved for the selected students; the selected students will in any case be required to comply with the administrative procedures necessary to obtain these grants, in accordance with the procedures set out in the Erasmus+ Call for applications. 6.3 It is the responsibility of the Student to apply for and obtain all visas and documents required by the country of the Partner University in order to carry out the mobility period.

6.4 Students are advised that during the mobility period they will need to abide by the regulations and rules in force in the host country and at the Partner University.

6.5 For information on health care abroad and insurance coverage for students during the period of mobility, please contact the International Office by the methods indicated in the section 'International' from the homepage of the University's website: www.univr.it.

ART. 8 - APPLICATIONS

8.1 Applications and the relevant attachments (if required) must be submitted by the methods indicated for each Double/Joint degree programme in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

ART. 9 – SELECTION PROCEDURES

9.1 Selection procedures, which may vary depending on each Double/Joint degree programme, are indicated in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document.

ART. 10 - PUBLICATION OF THE LIST OF ELIGIBLE STUDENTS AND CONFIRMATION

10.1 At the end of the selection procedures, a 'graduatoria' (list of eligible students) will be drawn up for each Double/Joint degree programme included in this Call, in accordance with the criteria set out in the individual programme factsheets attached to this document. The lists of admitted students for each programme, with an indication of any mobility grants awarded, will be published on the web page of the relevant degree programme.

10.2 If the student chooses to withdraw from the programme, or if their student status lapses, the mobility grant will be awarded to the next candidate on the list of eligible students, if still in time to participate in the programme.

10.3 The Selection Committee reserves the right not to allocate the available places if, in its sole discretion, no suitable candidates are identified in the selection process.


10.4 Selected applicants must communicate their acceptance by the methods and deadlines indicated in the 'graduatoria' or selection notice.

10.5 Selected applicants who do not confirm their acceptance by the above terms will be regarded as withdrawn from the selection process.


ART. 11 – ENROLMENT

11.1 Selected candidates who are not regularly enrolled at the University of Verona at the time of selection must complete their enrolment in the degree programme in which the Double/Joint degree option is offered before undertaking their programme of study.
