PLEASE NOTE: Pursuant to Ministry of Health Circular no. 51961 of 31/12/2022, the self-isolation period may be terminated **5 days after testing positive for the first time**, or **5 days** after the onset of symptoms, regardless of whether an antigenic or molecular test has been carried out, for those who have always been asymptomatic or who have not shown symptoms **for at least two days**. For those who have always been asymptomatic, the self-isolation period may end even earlier than 5 days if an antigenic or molecular test performed at a health facility/pharmacy proves negative. Anyone who knows they have been in close contact with a positive person must wear an FFP2 face mask for at least 5 days after the last contact, and take an antigenic or molecular test if symptoms appear. They should, therefore, take the exam or attend lectures in person, wearing an FFP2 face mask for at least 5 days after the last contact with a positive person.
